We'll be hosting our session over Zoom, so if you haven't already, make sure you create a profile and download the app for free by following this link: https://zoom.us/


IMPORTANT

- What's one thing parents could do (or stop doing) to help kids enjoy their sports activities more?
- What's the greatest or most worthwhile thing you've ever done? Was it an easy thing to do, or was it hard?
- Do you sometimes feel impatient to grow up? What are you looking forward to?
- When do you feel most connected to God? Is it when you are out in nature? When you hear a worship song? Something else?
- What's your favourite thing to do with your brother? And with your sister?
- Do you procrastinate a lot? What's your most frequent reason for procrastinating?
- What do you think kids your age worry about the most?

In Hawks Kids, one of the favourite activities is cooking. So, if you will...this is an easy to make recipe with your children...

Chunky monkey bites



Ingredients:

- 2 bananas
- 1/3 cups peanut butter/wow butter
- 1 package of chocolate chips (10-12oz)
- 1 tsb coconut oil

Instructions

- Slice the bananas (kids can do it) into medium-sized pieces and place on a parchment paper-covered baking sheet.
- 2. Add a small amount of peanut butter to every other banana piece, then sandwich together.
- 3. Freeze for at least 30 minutes.
- 4. In the meantime, melt the chocolate chips with the coconut oil.
- 5. When the bananas are chilled, dip each banana "bite" into the chocolate.
- 6. Return to the parchment paper and chill again until the bites are solid.
- 7. Keep in the refrigerator.
